Greetings Parents!

Working with middle school students I have found that one of the most difficult hurdles to overcome is the transition from children's ministry to student ministry. For many students, they never get to experience all that our middle school ministry offers because they didn't get involved during the first few months. I want you to know that I am very excited about getting your son/daughter involved in our ministry and want to help in whatever way I can.

When I begin to talk with incoming 7th grade students about the transition into student ministry I use these 5 key words:

FEAR: I tell them that the transition from being the "big shot" in children's ministry to being the youngest (and most often the smallest) in youth is scary. I want them to know that their feelings are natural and real. It is scary walking into a room of students who look old(er).

FUN: I explain that our student ministry will be fun. We want students to have a good time. "Laughter" and "celebration" are two key words we use to describe the value of fun. Most students use the word "boring" when they describe church. Because of this, we attempt to shatter the stereotype that church is boring. You may hear some wild things over the next six years and chances are good that they were intentional (although some wild things will happen that weren't planned that can sometimes be bad).

FAITH: Our primary goal is to help your child mature in his/her faith. We have a defined strategy with quality programs that assist students to grow in their faith. Our goal is the same goal God has for all Christians and that is to grow in the likeness of Jesus Christ. I want to emphasize the word "assist" because I know that one's spiritual growth isn't solely dependent on our student ministry. I believe, with all my heart, we have the best student ministry around. If a student wants to grow in his/her faith we can help at any place in their spiritual journey.

FINISH: I want to see students finish their time with us strong in their faith – knowing what it means to love God, love people and how to change their world. Our adult leadership is committed to seeing our graduating seniors having strong convictions about their faith, a lifestyle that reflects their convictions, and plans to serve God through ministry. It's our goal to see every student finish strong.

FRIENDS: "Students become like the people they hang out with." Even though students don't like to hear these words, I've seen that truth played out thousands of times over the years. Almost everything in middle school and high school revolves around friends! To finish strong, good friends are vital.

It is my goal for every student to have the opportunity to grow in his or her faith while in student ministry. I am committed to creating an environment where your son or daughter can discover how to love God, love people and their part in changing our world. Please don't be afraid to ask for help...if I can't help, I will find someone who can!

With that said, I hope you will register your son or daughter for **PASSAGE**, our confirmation program for this year (your Passage Registration Form is included in your packet). This is a 30-week program designed to build a solid spiritual foundation within your child. PASSAGE will take place on Sunday mornings from 11am to 12pm with our first class taking place on <u>August 6th</u>! I will be working together with our Passage leaders throughout the program this year and I am very excited.

I would encourage you to take a moment and look over the attached schedule. You will notice that we have **two mandatory retreats** – one in the fall and one in the spring. Also, there are **six passage gatherings** where your student and your student's faith friend get together. These also are mandatory. We also ask that your student make every attempt to attend most of the Sunday morning classes. We realize that schedules are crazy and you will have to miss a few. Finally, mark your calendars for **Sunday, April 22nd at 5:30pm** for Confirmation Sunday.

Each student will need to have a Faith Friend. You might be wondering, what is a Faith Friend? A Faith Friend is someone known to your family who will walk with your student through the Confirmation experience. This can be a close family friend, a favorite Sunday school teacher, etc. We only ask that they be the same sex as your child, not a relative and involved in a local church. This person will be responsible for making contact with your student once a week, praying for them, encouraging them and joining them for our six passage gatherings, our Confirmation Covenant Service, and Confirmation Sunday. There is a Faith Friend Fact Sheet in your packet that will need to be filled out and returned no later than July 24, 2017.

Now, this doesn't mean that you are off the hook parents. You have a huge role in the confirmation experience. Each week your student will get a "Take Home Sheet" for you and your family to do at home. You will also need to keep encouraging your student throughout the confirmation year! That's huge! We also will have a **PASSAGE Parent Meeting on Sunday, July 16th at 12:15 in The Garage**. This will be a great time to ask questions, meet other parents and confirmands and also finalize the registration packet. We will have a notary available to notarize the required forms.

The total cost of Confirmation is \$150. This covers the cost of the two retreats, supplies, and passage gatherings. We split the payments into two. The first payment of \$75.00 is due on Sunday, August 6, 2016 and the second payment of \$75.00 is due on Sunday, January 7, 2017. Please remember that if money is tight we have scholarships available if you will just let us know.

I am super excited for this year's confirmation experience. Please take a moment and fill out the registration form and turn that form in no later than **July 24, 2017**. WHAT IS A FAITH FRIEND?

1. **Make brief contact** with your confirmand once a week. This can be by phone, email, Facebook or text. The purpose of this contact is to encourage the confirmand and be available to answer any questions they might have about their confirmation experience.

2. **Pray daily for your confirmand**. This is huge! Take time each day to pray for your young friend as they embark on their faith journey!

3. **Make sure you are available for the six Passage Gatherings** (8/27, 10/22, 12/10, 1/21, 2/25, & 4/8). These will take place in The Garage at 12 noon to 2pm (two gatherings will take place on location at the bowling alley and putt-putt course).

4. **Mark your calendars** for our Confirmation Covenant Service (Friday, September 15th at 7pm in Logan Hall) and Confirmation Sunday on Sunday, April 22rd at 5:30pm!

Each Monday we will send you an email outlining that week's confirmation material. It will include that week's big point, the main passage, a few discussion points, and a challenge. Feel free to use this email as a springboard for your weekly discussion!
